<u>MEET & GREET</u>: The Friday night meet and greet at the Kurrajong Hotel, National Circuit in Barton, is a goer, this venue has provided the initial meeting place for the previous three CCCs, while this year's Meet & Greet might only be a small event for diehard CCC attendees it is a great place for an early evening sojourn. SATURDAY BREAKFAST: You are on your own for this one, although people staying at Rydges will have their buffet breakfast included in the accommodation cost.

TREASURE HUNT: Saturday morning sees the first vehicle event with the Treasure Hunt starting around 9:30 am at Rydges Eagle Hawk. This event replaces the Observation Run of previous years and should be a challenge to even the best crews. The event will take around 2 hours and cover up to 100km.
